Our Home Learning Challenge

Please choose two of the following challenges to complete at home and hand in to Mrs Donovan or Mrs Smith by Monday 26th February 2018.

- · Make paper snowflakes.
- Visit library and look for books which feature winter.
- · Make up a story about a winter adventure.
- Look for signs of winter: bare trees, frosty mornings, icy puddles, shorter days, winter clothes.
- Talk about favourite foods and why you like them.
- Talk about healthy diets and why it is important to eat a range of foods.
- Plan a picnic. Together make a list of all the things that will be needed. On the day, make sandwiches together & encourage your child to choose the filling.
- Visit library to find stories & rhymes that centre on food. Look out for children's recipe books that your child could enjoy using at home.
- · Visit a market or shop to buy fruit to make a fruit salad.
